Product Description

Specificity:

SNV-53 specificity is directed against the surface glycoprotein spike.

Background:

Hantavirus is an enveloped, negative-sensed, single-stranded RNA virus in the bunyavirus family¹. “New World” hantaviruses (NWH) are found in the Americas and may cause hantavirus pulmonary syndrome (HPS)². “Old World” hantaviruses (OWH) are found mostly in Europe and Asia and may cause hemorrhagic fever with renal syndrome. Each hantavirus serotype has a specific rodent host species and infection is spread by aerosolized urine, feces, saliva, or by rodent bites. Sin Nombre Virus (SNV), a NWH first isolated from rodents in the Southwestern United States, infects with a mortality rate of 50%¹. The probability of survival for Syrian hamsters infected with SNV significantly increases when treated postinfection with the monoclonal antibody (mAb) SNV-53³.

Formulation

This recombinant monoclonal antibody is aseptically packaged and formulated in 0.01 M phosphate buffered saline (150 mM NaCl) PBS pH 7.2 - 7.4 with no carrier protein, potassium, calcium or preservatives added. Due to inherent biochemical properties of antibodies, certain products may be

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prone to precipitation over time. Precipitation may be removed by aseptic centrifugation and/or filtration.

Purity

≥90% monomer by analytical SEC and SDS-Page

Storage and Stability

This antibody may be stored sterile as received at 2-8°C for up to one month. For longer term storage, aseptically aliquot in working volumes without diluting and store at ≤ -70°C. **Avoid Repeated Freeze Thaw Cycles.**

Product Preparation

Recombinant antibodies are manufactured in an animal free facility using only *in vitro* protein free cell culture techniques and are purified by a multi-step process including the use of protein A or G to assure extremely low levels of endotoxins, leachable protein A or aggregates.
